reinstatement of 20 employees removed/dis-
missed in the context of May 1974 strike
in pursuance of the orders contained in the
above ~~last~~ cited letter. There are still
six cases yet to be reinstated.

MYS Workshop.
- 2) M. LAKKIAH. "
- 3) K. VASANTHARAJ clerk/MYSS.

The above three were involved
in the strike that took place in April '74
in the MYSORE Workshop. S.Rly has
sought clarification from the Railway
Board whether they could also be brought
within the purview of the orders dt 6-4-77.

The following 3 employees were
prematurely retired immediately following
the strike on payment of 3 months pay
in lieu of notice.

- 1) A.R. Shaik Mastan, Head clerk/
personnel

- 2) S. A seervadham. Engg. Workshop
Arakonam.
- 3) Gajapadhi Babu, clerk,

MAS.

These three were retired in
June 1974 under review.

- 1) A.R. Shaik Mastan was the
President of the Trichy branch of
SRMU at the time of his termination.
- 2) S. A seervadham was the Vice-
president (central) of the SRMU.

These two cases are surely
and definitely for their participation
in the strike of May 1974. The Federation
has already taken up the case of
Shri A.R. Shaik Mastan with negat
result so far. I will be happy if
will kindly take up these six cases
also with the Railway Board's
reinstatement of employees and
become complete and total.
