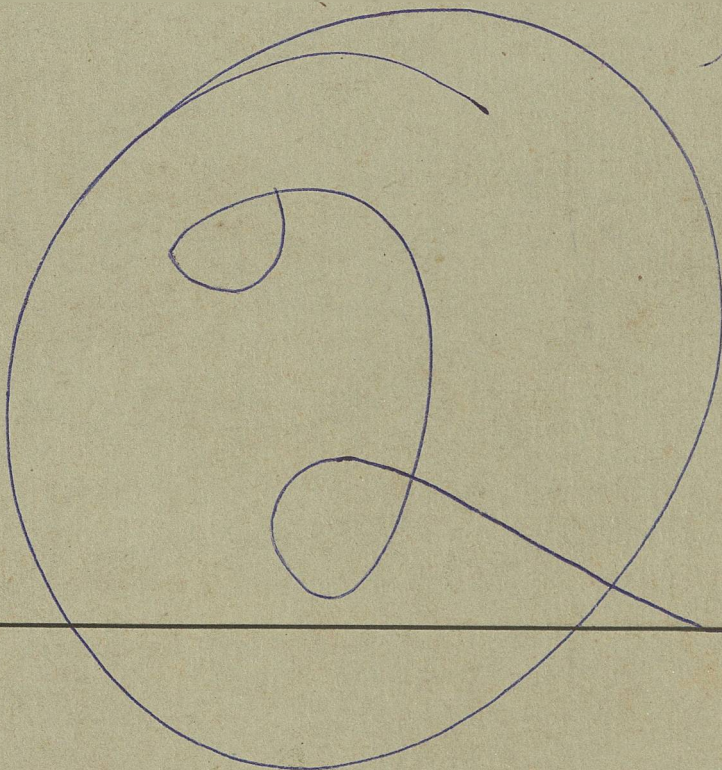





After the whole list had been prepared we received the cable from Cuba that they are sending a delegate. His name is Orlando Amury Benitez Hernandez and he holds a diplomatic passport No. 001645 Born December 1931. He has requested a visa at the airport. We are trying to arrange that.

They also require an interpreter. I have spoken to Sundriyal to find out whether Minu can come. In which case she can either come by Rajdhani with Indrajit on the 12th or by air with the delegates in which case you can arrange the air ticket through Saha and Rai.

Dear Comrade Pratul,

Herewith the list as of today. The names which are ticked require hotel accomodation, etc.

Two points to be noted :

1. In the case of the Bulgarian, GDR and Polish Delegation the Embassy have informed that they will do all the arrangements for their period of transit, etc. in Delhi. But you should keep in touch with the Embassy and ensure that they are being looked after. If you could meet them at the airport it would be helpful.
2. The comrades from Lebanon, Ethiopia have not yet informed their flight number. But they are also likely to come by SU 535 on 13.12.85 and will have to be put up in Janpath along with the others.
3. No news from Afghanistan as to their flight arrival. Please get in touch with the Embassy again.
4. Bangladesh, France, Italy, ~~Yugoslavia~~ Yugoslavia, ~~Iraq~~ Iraq, Czechoslovakia ~~and~~ are coming direct to Baroda via Bombay. About the Australian delegate there is no news of his flight but he may come either through Bombay or through Delhi. So Narasimhan will inform you if any cable is received.




Smt. Parvathi Krishnan, Secretary of the AITUC had a




