HELD AT BOMBAY ON 15 DECEMBER 1963 at 12 noon.

It was decided that the resolution passed in the conference
should be translated in all regional languages by the
STUCs by 25th December and a few copies sent to the AITUC
centre.

It was decided that to help the campaign, small pamphlets
should be brought out on the following topics:

- ✓ 1. Prices and Taxes
- ✓ 2. Wages, D.A. and Index (M.C.)
- ✓ 3. Minimum Wages
- ✓ 4. Bonus (S.S.)
- ✓ 5. Nationalisation of Export-Import trade
- ✓ 6. Nationalisation of sugar industry
- ✓ 7. Nationalisation of oil industry (D)
- ✓ 8. Nationalisation of banking industry
- ✓ 9. State trading in foodgrains and fair price
for agricultural produce

It was agreed that the Minimum wages pamphlet would be
drafted by Com. Balachandra Menon, on Prices and taxes
by B.D.Joshi (Prem Sagar Gupta), State trading by Elias,
Sugar nationalisation by Ram Asrey and on Bank nationalisa-
tion by K.T.K.Tangamani. These booklets should be out by 7th
January 1964.
